PLANETARY CITIZENS



As citizens, we can work toward a humane economic and social system, featuring international cooperation and respect for all people. The United Nations could transform into a just, comprehensive, and sustainable system of global governance, within an effective worldwide rule of law.

TRANSNATIONAL CORPORATE REGULATION

The United Nations program called The Global Compact is the start of transnational corporate responsibility. Only a global structure can enforce regulations that require businesses and corporations to do right by the environment.



UNIVERSAL EDUCATION



The governments have agreed that every school in the world should teach Human Rights, Sustainable Development and Peace.

LAND VALUE TAXATION

The International Union for Land Value Taxation focuses on how taxation policy can better serve the people. In Ecuador, President Correa has introduced a very



comprehensive reform to eliminate all taxes on services and labor and apply them to the possession of land.

THE BILL OF SOCIAL RIGHTS

The Bill of Social Rights says simply this: the United Nations is going to see that every person on this planet has food, clothes, fresh drinking water, adequate preventative medical care, education up through College, a job commensurate to their education and training, and in old age Social Security. NEW GLOBAL INSTITUTIONS OUTSIDE THE UN



In an informal process, the International Criminal Court started with a small number of governments cooperating with civil society, as did the Land Mine Treaties and an International Renewable Energy Agency.

A UNITED NATIONS PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY

If the UN is to be strengthened, at the same time it has to be made more democratic and responsive. One means to achieve this aim is a United Nations Parliamentary Assembly, the UNPA. Party groups would send delegates to fill each country's seats according to their percentage of the national legislature.



The first step would be a vote by the UN General Assembly to establish a consultative body under Article 22 of the UN Charter. A UNPA posits the direct relationship of every individual to the planet, without national governments or other bodies as go-betweens. It moves the world toward a true global community, with a growing political integration, striving for an eventual world federation. The Assembly would be the manifestation and vehicle of a global consciousness and a new understanding of international politics. The legitimate parliamentary representatives of 127 countries in the world have spoken out for its creation.
